Taxiway Bravo Pavement Work

On Wednesday, December 1st, Runway 25R will not be available for full length departures from 12:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Taxiway Bravo is scheduled to close between Taxiway Foxtrot and Taxiway Bravo One during the aforementioned times to facilitate concrete maintenance. This taxiway closure will reduce the available runway length from 12,091 feet to 11,134 feet. All aircraft should plan to depart Runway 25R from Taxiway Foxtrot. A Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) will be issued 72 hours prior to the scheduled closure. Please plan your flight operations accordingly.
