



RELIANT IMMEDIATE CARE FACILITY AND SECURITY POST 3 TO BE IMPACTED BY PLANNED POWER OUTAGE ON THURSDAY, AUGUST 24, 2017 FROM 9 AM TO 5 PM

The Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) will temporarily shut down power to a vault located on the northeast area of the airport. This will affect several nearby locations.

Reliant Immediate Care – There will be no admission to the facility during the power outage. There will be signs at the entrances informing patients of the closure and to seek medical attention at a different medical care facility or to call 911. The First Aid Station located in the Tom Bradley International Terminal in the southeast corner of ticketing will still be available.

Security Post 3 – The access to this post will likely be closed. An emergency generator may be used to supply power to the post but accessibility to the post is not assured. Change in status will be updated via the Everbridge message.

The Airport Police Station on 96th Street will be operating under emergency power and may have limited functionality. The Employee Parking Lots and Lot C are not expected to be effected by the outage but are prepared to process vehicles manually in the event they are.

All airport employees, tenants, stakeholders, service providers, and general contractors are advised of this advisory are encouraged to disseminate the information to all concerned.
