



Runway Holding Position Markings, Signs & Lights: Denote the intersection of a Taxiway and entrance to a Runway. Never cross these signs, markings or flashing yellow lights.

### REPORT ALL SAFETY CONCERNS TO AIRPORT OPERATIONS 24/7 | CALL (424) 646-9071

**Disabled Vehicles/Equipment** - Call Airport Ops immediately to ensure your safety and the safety of aircraft, especially if blocking a taxiway.

**If lost or unsure where you can drive** - remain on the service road and call Airport Ops for help, a unit will be dispatched to your location to assist.

**To report Foreign Object Debris (FOD)** - Call Airport Ops for a unit to be dispatched. It is helpful to provide the location and description of the FOD.

### ZIPPER MARKING

Denotes where a vehicle service road crosses a taxiway. **Do not stop in this area** 

### STOP FOR AIRCRAFT YIELD TO AIRCRAFT

Denotes where vehicles must stop and yield to all aircraft

### STOP SIGN

Denotes where all vehicles must come to a complete stop

### STOP FOR LANDING AIRCRAFT SIGN Denotes where vehicles must

stop and yield to landing aircraft

### TAXIWAY LOCATION SIGN

Identifies Taxiway on which Vehicle/Aircraft is located

TAXIWAY DIRECTION SIGN

Defines general direction of an

intersecting taxiway

### RUNWAY HOLDING POSITION SIGN

Indicates the entrance to a runway. Remain clear. Co-located with a taxiway location sign

## Safe Driver Checklist:

- 1. Be familiar with airfield layout, signs, and markings.
- Conduct a walk around inspection of your vehicle & GSE to check the condition before driving.
- 3. **Never** drive on a taxiway or runway. Remain on vehicle service roads and ramp areas.
- 4. Do not stop inside zipper markings, these are where service roads cross taxiways.
- 5. Ensure there is no backup of vehicles before proceeding across zipper markings.
- 6. Always maintain situational awareness.
- 7. Yield to aircraft and emergency vehicles.
- 8. Know and comply with all AOA speed limits.
- 9. Reduce speed & use additional caution when driving in fog, rain, gusting winds & at night.
- 10. Use caution for aircraft engine jet blast.
- 11. Park only in designated parking locations.
