1. Airline Gate 131 Re-Opening

- Airline Gate 131 in Terminal B's North Concourse, which has been closed since April 2017, is scheduled to re-open this week on Wednesday, July 22 (previously reported to re-open late June 2020)
- The gate was closed to facilitate work for the Midfield Satellite Concourse – North (MSC) Project

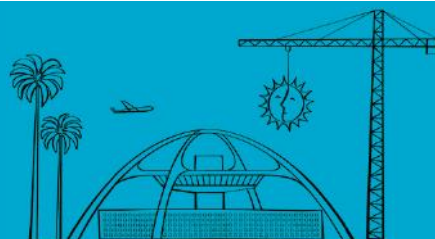


Top: Airline Gate 131 is scheduled to re-open this week after being closed since April 2017 for MSC North Project activity

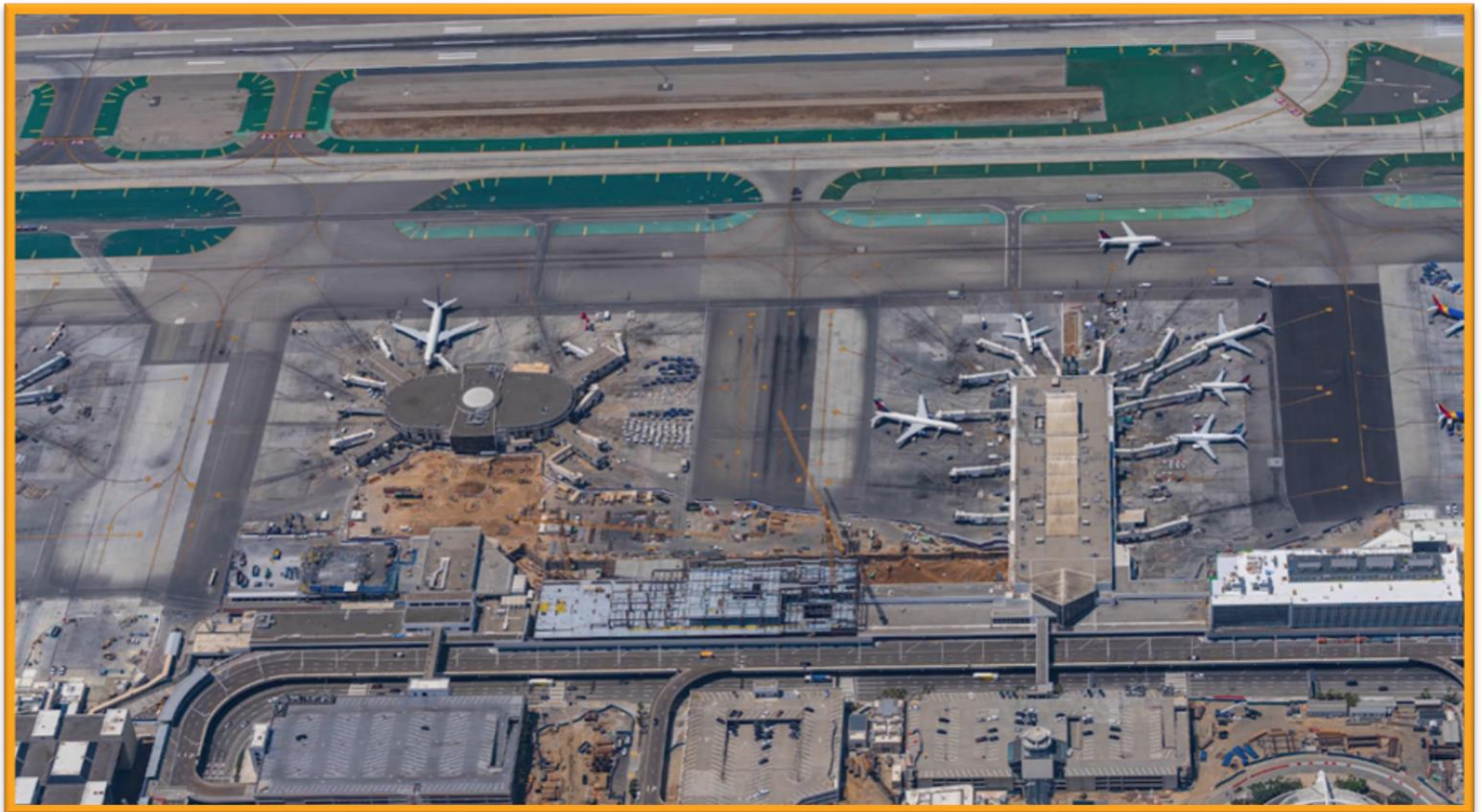

2. Terminal 2 / 3: Construction Update

- Steel erection continues on the future Terminal 2 / 3 Head House building as part of the Delta Sky Way program
- Aerial imagery captured last week shows the overall progress on the program, with the Head House building foundation visible between the two terminals and the Terminal 3 concourse hall to the satellite building completely demolished

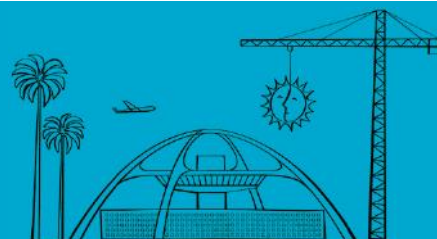


Top: Future Terminal 2 / 3 Head House during steel erection

3. Rescheduled: Parking Structure 3 Ingress Impacts

- Potholing work at Parking Structure 3 for the Automated People Mover project, which was scheduled to occur last week, has been rescheduled for July 27 through August 6
- Work impacting the first (long term parking) entrance will now occur nightly for the first week and continuously for the second week
- Signage will be in place to assist with wayfinding when the entrance is closed
