## 1. LAX Holiday Construction Moratoriums

- The Christmas / New Year's Holiday Construction Moratorium is currently in effect through Tuesday, January 4, 2022 at 6AM
- The 2022 Super Bowl Construction Moratorium will be in effect Thursday, February 10 at 6AM through Tuesday, February 15 at 6AM

## 2. Smart Parking: Project Updates

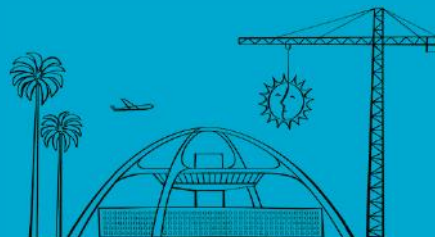
- Work on the Smart Parking Project in CTA Parking Structures will resume this month following the end of the Holiday Construction Moratorium
- In Parking Structures 3 and 4, work to install electronic parking guidance systems will reduce available spaces throughout January
- Similar work and impacts will occur in Parking Structures 5 and 6, where new EV chargers were recently installed and open for use

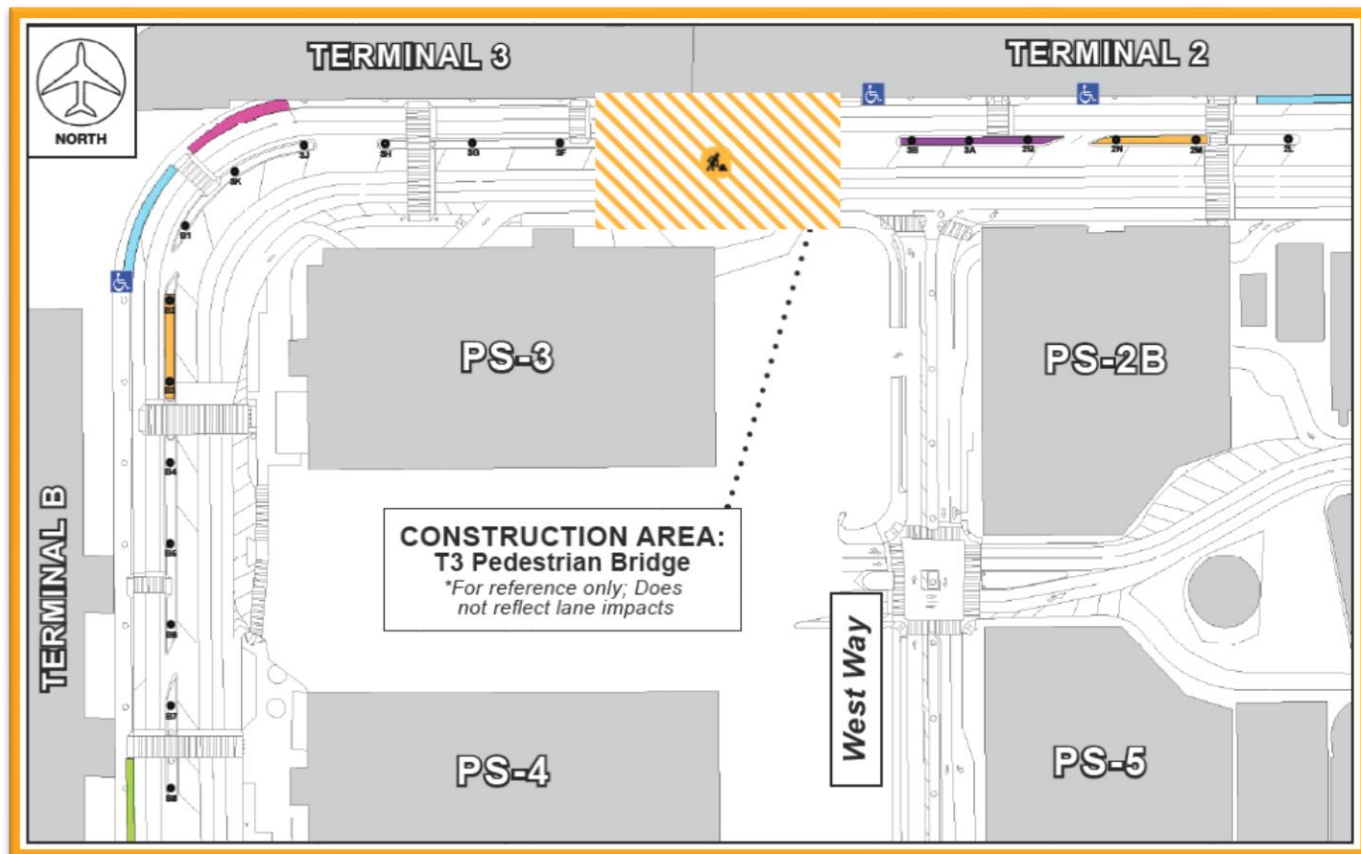

## 3. Automated People Mover: Terminal 3 Pedestrian Bridge

- Construction of a Pedestrian Bridge to connect Terminal 3 to the APM's West CTA Station is scheduled to begin next week
- Nightly lane restrictions and / or full closures on Arrivals and Departures Level roadways are required through mid-February to facilitate construction
- Detour and temporary wayfinding signage, along with flaggers, will be utilized to maintain traffic and pedestrian flow during construction

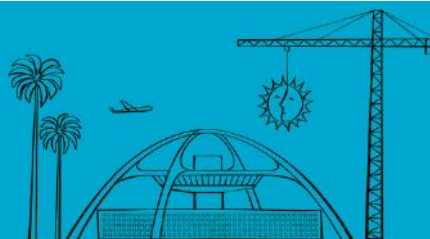


Terminal 2.5 Pedestrian Bridge, constructed September 2021, for reference

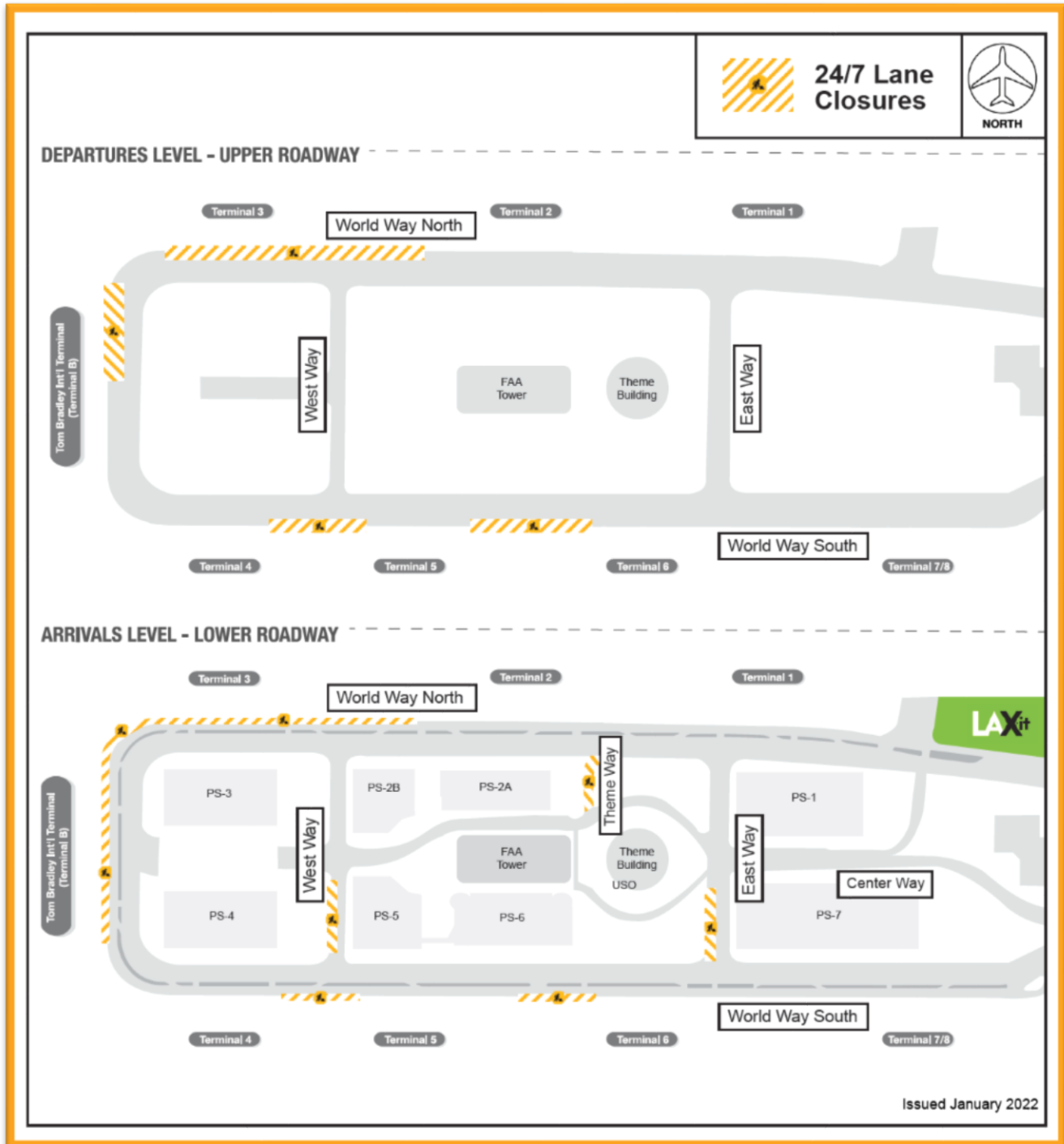
