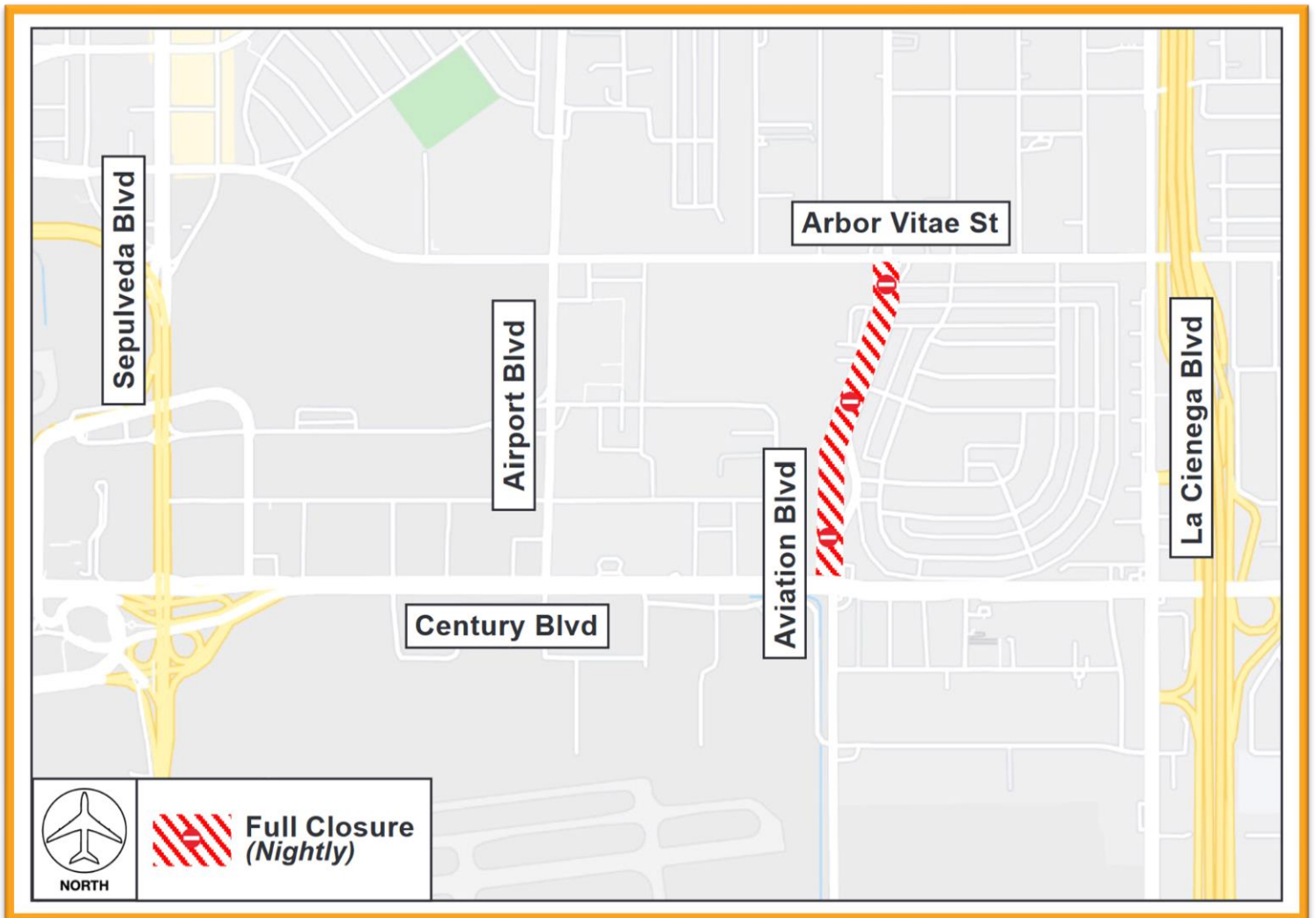

## 1. Aviation Boulevard Closed Nightly through February

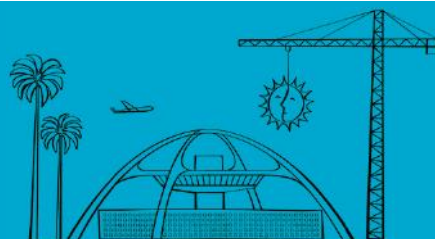
- To facilitate work for the Automated People Mover project, Aviation Boulevard between Arbor Vitae Street and Century Boulevard will be closed through Tuesday, February 28
- These closures will be implemented nightly from 9PM to 6AM
- Detours are in place to ensure traffic is maintained at all times



*Traffic will be detoured nightly while a portion of Aviation Boulevard is closed nightly for the APM project*

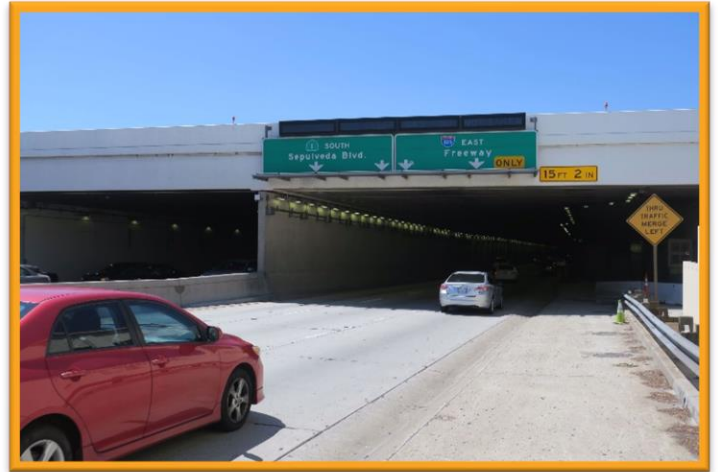

## 2. Sepulveda Tunnel Fire Detection Upgrades

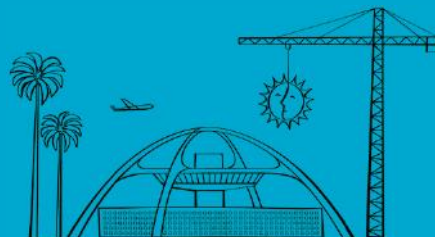
- To facilitate the City of Los Angeles Bureau of Street Services' Fire Detection Upgrade Project, the Sepulveda Tunnel will experience lane restrictions beginning tonight, February 6 through February 26, nightly from 11PM to 5AM
- Phase 1: Outside Lanes (2/6 – 2/13) north- and southbound outer two lanes closed, including Upper CTA transition ramp to SB Sepulveda)
- Phase 2: Inside Lanes (2/13 – 2/20) north- and southbound inner two lanes closed
- Contingency (2/20 – 2/26): Contingency dates for final inspection and weather delays
- One lane of traffic will be maintained at all times



The Sepulveda Tunnel will experience nightly lane restrictions for two to three weeks while its fire detection system is upgraded

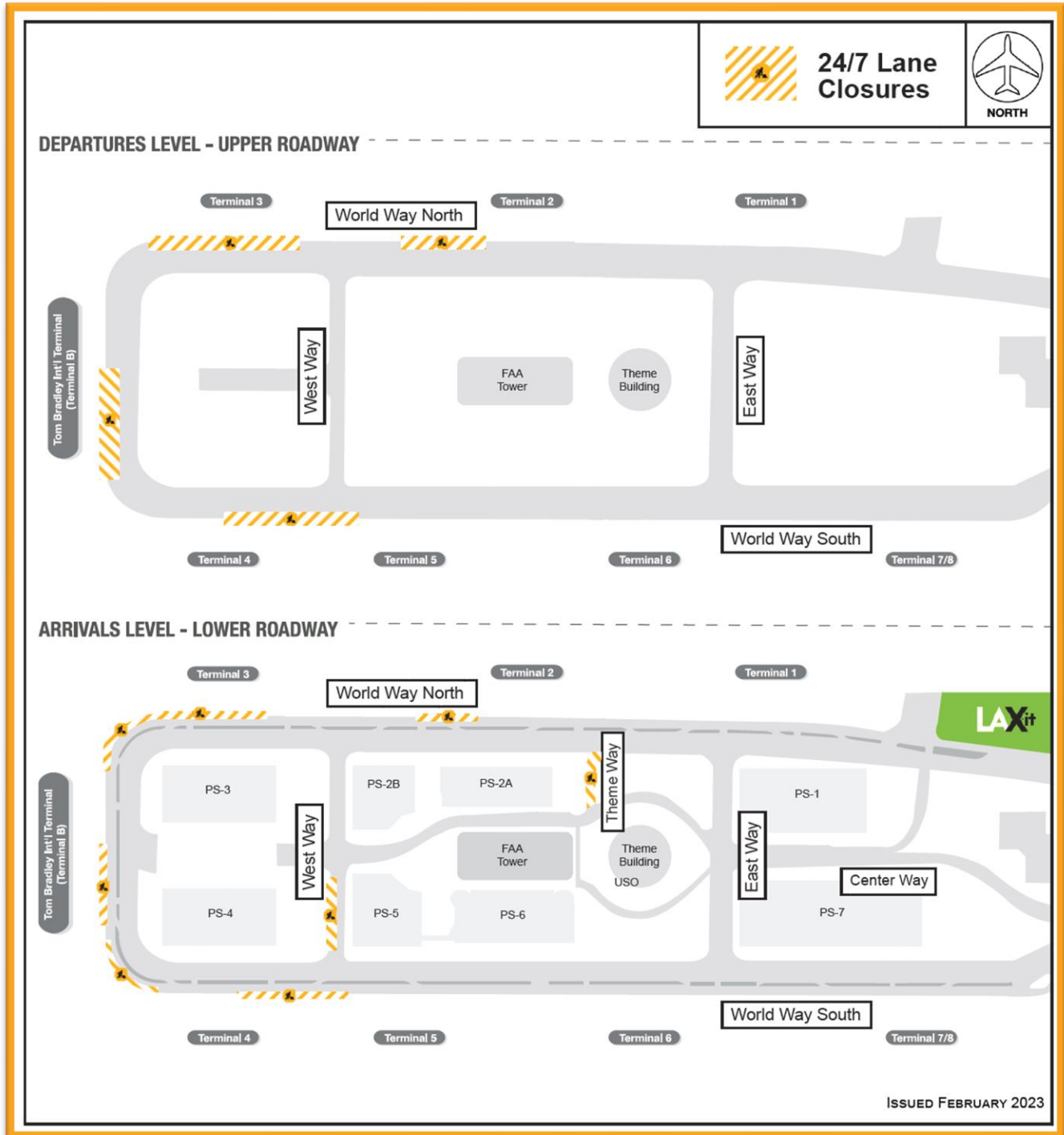
