#1 STREET IMPACTS: LA CIENEGA BLVD & SB I-405 RAMPS THROUGH NOV. '24

To facilitate roadway reconstruction for the RUE Project, the following impacts will be in place through Nov. 2024:

WEEKNIGHTS STARTING 9/18 Hours: Nightly 9PM to 6AM


 Nightly Directional Lane Closures on La Cienega Blvd between Century Blvd and Arbor Vitae St
Closure of SB I-405 On Ramp

WEEKENDS STARTING 9/20

Hours: Fridays at 11PM continuous (24/7) through Mondays at 6AM

 Full Closure (both directions) of La Cienega Blvd between Century Blvd and Arbor Vitae St
Closure of SB I-405 Off & On Ramps

Access to local businesses will be maintained at all times. Detour signage will be in place. Please use caution when traveling near construction areas and plan ahead for potential delays.



#2 STREET IMPACTS: WESTBOUND CENTURY BLVD SEPTEMBER 20 - 23

To facilitate civil construction for the APM Project, westbound lanes on Century Blvd at Avion Dr will be restricted Fri. 9/20 through Mon. 9/23 with at least two lanes of WB Century Blvd maintained at all times. Flaggers and signage will be in place to facilitate vehicular and pedestrian traffic.



#3 TERMINAL 4 IMPACTS: PED BRIDGE CLOSURE & BARRICADE REMOVAL

Please be advised of the following major construction ongoing at Terminal 4 throughout the next month as crews work to (1) demolish the existing pedestrian bridge at Terminal 4 / Parking Structure 4, and (2) remove Arrivals Level curbside barricades between Terminals 4 & 5.

As part of the APM Project, the existing pedestrian bridge between T-4 and PS-4 is now permanently closed for demolition (scheduled for mid-October 2024); alternate routes and detour signage are in place between T-4 and PS-4.





As work on the American Airlines T4/5 Modernization Program progresses to its next stage, curbside Arrivals Level barricades and the temporary sidewalk extension are scheduled to be removed over the coming weeks. #4 SEPTEMBER 2024: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

The map below is a collective snapshot of all scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of September 2024.

PLEASE NOTE:

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; other nightly lane closures / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

ACCESS MAINTAINED:

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off.
