


CONSTRUCTION HOT TOPICS



It has been announced that LAX's Automated People Mover (APM) is anticipated to begin service to passengers in January 2026, with construction activities scheduled for completion by December 8, 2025.

The LAX APM will operate 24/7 with trains arriving every 2 minutes during peak travel times. It will provide access to all terminals, parking structures, rideshare options, the LAX Rental Car Center, Metro's LAX Metro Transit Center, and more!


TERMINAL 4 AIRLINE GATES CLOSING & RE-OPENING

The following are scheduled dates for Airline Gates closing or re-opening in Terminal 4:

CLOSING THIS WEEK: August 7, 2024 Gates 47A & 47B

Projected re-opening: January 2025

RE-OPENING: Mid-October 2024 Gates 46B, 46C, 48A, 48B, 49A, & 49B Closed since April 2022









#4 **AUGUST 2024:** 24/7 CTA LANE **RESTRICTIONS**

The map below is a collective snapshot of all scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of August 2024.

PI FASE NOTE:

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA: other nightly lane closures / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

ACCESS MAINTAINED:

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off.

PLAN AHEAD:

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays.
