

### NIGHTLY LANE RESTRICTIONS: CENTURY BLVD + LA CIENEGA BLVD

To facilitate work by the Roadway & Utility Enabling Project, lane restrictions will be in place at the intersection of Century Boulevard & La Cienega Boulevard beginning Monday, February 3 through Friday, February 7, nightly from 9PM to 6AM.

Additionally, the SB I-405 Off Ramp south of Century Boulevard will be closed as needed during this time (nightly work hours only) to facilitate work.

Traffic will be maintained at all times via open lanes or, when necessary, detours. Flaggers will be in place to facilitate local access.

Please watch for posted signage and always use caution when traveling near construction areas.

## FEBRUARY 2025: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

Here is a collective snapshot of scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of February 2025.

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA: nightly lane / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off and ingress to / egress from parking structures.

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays and use caution when traveling near construction areas.
